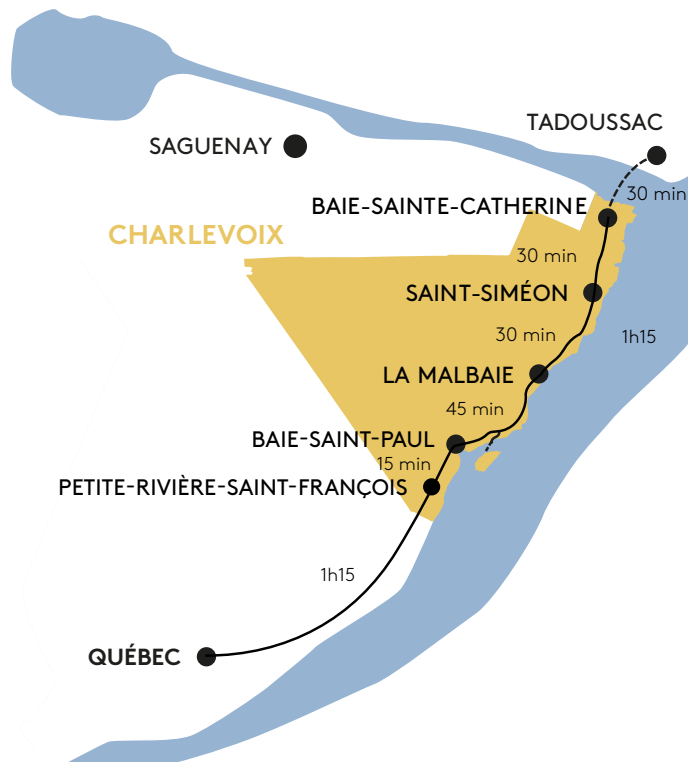
Day 1 | From Québec to Baie-Saint-Paul

Leaving from Québec, take the route towards Petite-Rivière-Saint-François and the **Massif de Charlevoix**, where you can admire the view from a gondola or even try mountain biking. Keep going to explore the rich heritage of the town of Baie-Saint-Paul, strolling along **Saint-Jean-Baptiste Street** with its inspiring art galleries and unique architecture.

Day 2 | In the heart of the mountains

Want to get to know some emus? The **Centre de l'Émeu de Charlevoix** is the largest breeding farm in Canada. With over 400 emus, you will have ample opportunity to get to know this fascinating animal. A bit further down, the **Grands-Jardins National Park** is the ideal place to stretch your legs while discovering unique alpine flora. The hiking there is exceptional. Finally, take the ferry from Saint-Joseph-de-la-Rive to Isle-aux-Coudres where you can enjoy a moment to yourself on the water.

Day 3 | An island of discoveries

Traveling through Isle-aux-Coudres lets you explore at your own pace. Take the time to stop at the artisanal shops to get to know their art and passion, like the **Cidrerie et Vergers Pedneault** where you can learn the secrets of making cider and visit their production workshop. Not to be missed: **Moulins de l'Isle-aux-Coudres**, the only place in America where you will see both a watermill and windmill together in one exceptional setting. End the day in La Malbaie where you can dive into the history of the region at the **Musée de Charlevoix**, then head to the **Casino de Charlevoix** for an unforgettable night.

Day 4 | La Malbaie and surrounding area
